

Care Instructions

Wooden Furniture

Wood and wood veneers may display different grain patterns depending on which way its cut . The natural beauty of its grains and patterns forms its natural characteristics properties of the wood itself .

Some furniture aged naturally and some are deliberately .

Wood veneers also creates distinctive patterns on some surfaces , such as table tops , drawer fronts , side panels .

All timber and veneer surfaces will change colour and oxidize over time . New furniture will initially vary in shade from items that have been previously purchased .

Care for wood furniture

- Avoid placing your wooden furniture in direct sunlight
- Use coasters, placemats and tablecloths to protect furniture during use.
- Lift and place items to reduce any sliding friction sliding across furniture surfaces.
- Rotate placement of accessories on the furniture to avoid any permanent marks from forming on the wood.
- Clean furniture regularly with a dampened soft cloth.
- Dry all water spots on the surface with another clean soft cloth to prevent any permanent marks from forming on the wood.
- Dust your wooden furniture regularly to prevent any dirt from accumulating.

Safety instruction

Exercise care and precaution when moving furniture as careless handling may cause injury and damage . Never drag furniture . Always lift it . Periodically check all fixtures to ensure none have come loose . Re-tighten as and when necessary . Incorrect assembly of furniture can be dangerous . Assembly should be carried out by competent personal . No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrect assembled furniture .

Heavy item warning
